

City of Powers Lake
Special Meeting

The Powers Lake City Council met in special session on Thursday, December 16, 2021 at 8:00 am. Council members present were: Holmen, Griesbach, Hockenbary, and Carlson. Also present was the auditor.

Mayor Albertson called the meeting to order.

Albertson gave an update on the reference checks on candidates for the chief of police position. Motion Griesbach, seconded by Holmen to hire Bryton Allard as chief of police with the following benefits: \$50,000 gross pay/year; \$600 gross pay/month in lieu of health insurance; police house; NDPER-LE retirement; equipment/uniforms; and sick/vacation as outlined in the employee handbook. Roll call vote resulted in ayes unanimous.

Motion by Hockenbary, seconded by Carlson to have the old fire hall lot surveyed to establish the property line. Roll call vote resulted in ayes unanimous.

Discussion was held on the drainage project and police station/city hall.
