Regular Meeting
Unapproved Proceedings

The Powers Lake City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, March 3, 2020 at 8:00 am. Council members present were: Ledene, Griesbach, Hockenbary and Carlson. Also present were Daniel Swanson with Ackerman Estvold, Kenny MacDonald, Randy Mehlhoff, Police Chief Lerol, and the auditor. Council president Carlson called the meeting to order.

Mayor Albertson called into the meeting and discussion was held on the old Cenex building. At this time, the city is waiting to see what happens with the Cenex shop closing.

Motion by Griesbach, seconded by Ledene to approve the February minutes. Motion carried.

Motion by Hockenbary, seconded by Griesbach to approve the financial report. Motion carried.

Landfill/building permits: Building permit for Jim Grossman – cold storage building approved. The auditor will advertise for a landfill worker.

Streets/Legion Hall: Discussion was held on the asphalt at the intersection of 2nd Ave & Main Street as well as by the school. KEM will be back in town this spring to replace more valley gutters.

Water/Sewer: A new injector pump was ordered.
