## Capital Improvement Projects

1. Drainage Improvement – concrete culvert along 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave from west of old fire hall to east of city hall – estimated cost \$479,342.00
2. Water and Sewer Extension – north of 5<sup>th</sup> Ave E along Johnson St. – estimated cost \$322,447.50
3. Police Station – estimated cost \$200-\$225 per sq/ft
4. Community Building – estimated cost of \$200-\$225 per sq/ft and \$200K - \$300K for parking lot
