BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POWERS LAKE, BURKE COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA THAT ORDINANCE #118 BE AMENDED TO ADD THE FOLLOWING SECTION.

Construction and maintenance of water and sewer services lines from an existing main:

- 1. All water and sewer service line construction must have a completed water and sewer permit application filed with the city auditor and approved by the city council prior to construction.
- 2. All water and sewer service lines must be constructed by a licensed and bonded contractor; a trench box is required. All work must be inspected by city maintenance prior to cover-up.
- 3. Construction costs of new water and sewer service lines from an existing main are the responsibility of the property owner, including re-paying the street.
- 4. Construction of water and sewer mains by property owners must extend the mains to the furthest end of the property.
- 5. For maintenance and expenses of existing water and service lines, the city is responsible from the main to the curbstop. The property owner is responsible from the curbstop to the structure.

This first reading held July 6, 2015, with the second reading and final passage to be held August 5, 2015.
